

About Mame...in its many incarnations

Mame, by librettists Jerome Lawrence and Robert E. Lee, opened on Broadway in 1966 and played 1,508 performances, earning 1966 Tony Awards for Angela Lansbury, Frankie Michaels and Beatrice Arthur. (The original cast also featured Jane Connell and Willard Waterman.) Composer and lyricist Jerry Herman caught his share of the spotlight—and the 1967 Grammy Award for Best Musical Show Album—with hits including "It's Today," "Open a New Window," "We Need a Little Christmas," "My Best Girl" and "Bosom Buddy." Singer Eydie Gormé received a 1967 Grammy Award for her recording of "If He Walked into My Life," while a year earlier Bobby Darin, Louis Armstrong and Herb Alpert each saw their covers of the title song hit the charts.

First published in 1955, Patrick Dennis's semi-autobiographical novel Auntie Mame sold over two million copies and claimed a spot on the New York Times bestseller list for more than 112 weeks. According to biographer Eric Myers, Dennis (in real life Edward Everett "Pat" Tanner III) insisted that the title character was more a reflection of himself than his own Aunt Marion. He said the characteristic best shared by the women was that both were "crazy."

Indeed, the lead role was established by actresses known to "live life well": notably, Angela Lansbury, Rosalind Russell and Lucille Ball. Contemporary performers who clamor to be cast as Mame include Bette Midler and Madonna. The story has been made into a play, both a Broadway and Hollywood musical, and several movies.

"Auntie Mame is America's diabolical answer to Mary Poppins," Paul Rudnick observes in his introduction to the 2001 Broadway Books edition of the novel. He describes Dennis as a "brilliant social observer and a detail addict." During the mid-1950s and early 1960s, Dennis's light comic novels were enormously popular. By 1974 Dennis felt his words had fallen out of fashion; he began a new career as butler to the rich and famous, most notably McDonald's founder Roy Kroc. Today, his American approach to the "High Camp" style is enjoying a revival and continues to influence new writers.
