Official Contest Rules

Eligibility

California High School students are encouraged to participate in the art contest being funded by Washington County Drug and Alcohol Commission and held in collaboration with California University of PA. Students must be attending California High School at the time of the opening of the contest (May, 2019). Graduating seniors (June, 2019) are eligible.

Entering the Contest

A brief application must be filled out by all students who wish to enter the contest in order to be eligible for prize money and recognition. Submission materials include: A visual art piece that discourages underage drinking (painting, drawing, or sculpture) and does not weigh over 20 lbs. Feel free to be creative. **Note**: Students can work together to create a submission. Each student must fill out their own brief application and list the other student(s) who are submitted the entry with them. If the entry is selected as a winner, the prize money will be split between all entrants (but only those mutually listed on applications for the entry).

Entries must be submitted by July 19, 2019 to be eligible. Until the last day of school (June 3, 2019) entries may be submitted in room 116 at the high school. After the last day of school, entries may be submitted at California University of PA, Wellness Center located on the ground floor of Carter Hall in G53.

Ownership of Entries

All entries submitted in connection with this contest, along with all copyright, trademark, and other proprietary rights associated therewith, become the property of Washington County Drug and Alcohol Commission and California University of PA upon submission. Entry materials will not be returned to any entrant. By submitting an entry, you acknowledge that if you win the contest, Washington County Drug and Alcohol Commission and California University of PA will own all rights to use, modify, reproduce, publish, perform, display, distribute and promote the presentation in perpetuity without compensation to you or any other person.

Selection of Winners

Winners will be selected and notified during Riverfest, August 24-25, 2019. Winners do not need to be present at Riverfest to receive prizes. Art contest organizers reserve the right to extend the deadline to an alternate date and/or expand the invitation to additional high schools.

Use of Name, Likeness, Etc.

As a condition of entering the contest and receiving any prize, each winner and their parents or legal guardians will be required to consent to the use of their name, age, area of residence, and school name. You will also be required to be interviewed for any publicity for feature stories and interviews for print, online, and television. You must also consent to using your likeness and prize information, without limitations without further payment.

Release

By entering the contest, you and your parents or legal guardians release and agree to hold harmless Washington County Drug and Alcohol Commission and California University of PA, and each of their employees, from any liability whatsoever in connection with entering the contest, accepting any prize monies, or anything that may arise related to the contest.
