To Whom It May Concern (Guidance Counselor),

The University of Pittsburgh's Army ROTC (AROTC) Program would like to formally announce that the application process for the 4-year National Army ROTC Scholarship is now open to new applications! The application process is open for rising high school seniors from now until 25 January 2019 @ 1159pm EST. If a student successfully submits an application and is approved for the scholarship, the Army will pay the tuition at any participating 4-year college or university for the entirety of the student's undergraduate career (omitting any issues that may arise on the student's behalf). In turn, the student would agree to enter Army service following graduation as a newly minted Army Officer in the component and branch of their choice.

Specifically, the AROTC at Pitt would like to share some statistics regarding our own program that may interest any student looking into attending Pitt or joining ROTC:

1. In the last year, our program has issued scholarships to incoming freshman totaling over \$4,800,000.
2. In the past seven years, our program has been one of the top ten best AROTC programs in the entire nation and is the third largest (excluding Senior Military Institutes).
3. We maintain the second highest female to male ratio of cadets in the country.
4. Our program encompasses the following academic institutions: University of Pittsburgh, University of Pittsburgh at Greensburg, Duquesne University, Robert Morris University, Carnegie Mellon University, California University of Pennsylvania, Franciscan University of Steubenville, Washington and Jefferson College, Point Park University, Carlow University, La Roche College, and Chatham University.

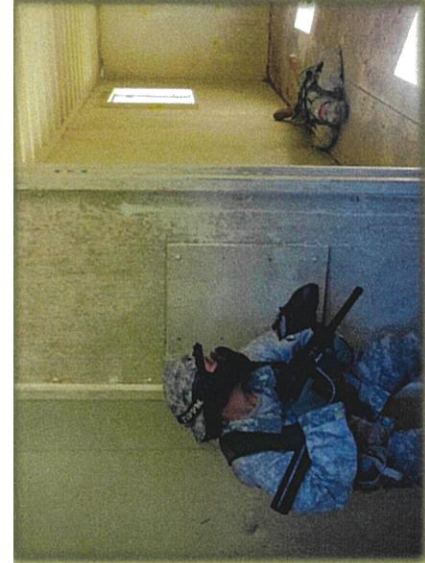
