Dear Families and Graduating Seniors,

On Monday, May 18, 2020, graduating seniors are scheduled to pick up caps and gowns.

When you arrive, you will be asked to do the following:

- Review a Communication Release to allow the school district to share your image / photo with the newspaper, electronic publications, and recordings. We are putting together a DVD of a collage of senior class pictures, the Senior powerpoint with senior portrait and baby picture, along with a collection of sports pictures, field trip pictures, etc. In order to include you in the electronic recording, I will need your permission.

Each student already has a Communication Release on file (completed at the beginning of the school year) however, I would like to have an updated release due to the amount of pictures we will record on the DVD for each graduating senior.

A copy of this letter is also attached for your family to review.

- Take inventory and check off that you received your cap, gown and tassel. We want to make sure you received what you ordered in case there are items missing.
- You will receive your immunization card. **THIS IS A VERY IMPORTANT DOCUMENT!** In the future you will need this card for a variety of reasons.
- You will also receive your baby picture to take home.

You will also be asked to:

- Vote for the date that you as a graduating senior would prefer. The ballot is attached for your review prior to voting. Mr. Webb, Mrs. Reposky and Mrs. Neason will be available to answer questions regarding the ballot, voting, etc.
- Once all ballots from every graduating senior has been submitted, the ballots will be counted by Mary Bastin, the Board Secretary and Secretary to the Superintendent. The results will be announced at the Board meeting on May 20.

Again, I ask that you abide by Governor Wolf's regulations. Please wear a mask for your protection as well as the protection of our school personnel.
